










What is the Early Years Foundation Stage?

The Early Years Foundation Stage (E.Y.F.S.) is the stage of education for children from birth to the end of the Reception year.

It is based on the recognition that children learn best through play and active learning.



# What is the EYFS?

- Early Years Foundation Stage is the National Curriculum for children in Nursery and Reception.
- 4 There are 3 Prime areas of learning:
- Communication and Language.
- Physical Development.
- Personal Social and Emotional Development.
  - There are 4 Specific areas of learning:
  - Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the World
  - **Expressive Arts and Design**
- All areas of learning are reflected inside and outdoors



### PSED

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Making friends
- 4 Learning rules
- Learning daily routines
- Learning about other cultures and respect
- Understanding boundaries
- 4 Making good
  - relationships with adults







## PSED - How can you help?

- You can help by encouraging your child to use the toilet independently, wash their hands.
- 4 Put on and fasten their coats, clothes and shoes.
- Eat with a knife and fork.
- Playing games which encourage sharing and turn taking will help your child to build their social skills.








#### PD Physical Development



- Gross and fine motor skills
- Malleable resources
   (play dough and construction kits)
- Fasten shoes and coats
- Outdoor area, climbing frame
- </u> Pencil control







# Physical Development How can you help?

- Give children time to run, jump, climb and play outdoors.
- Encourage children to take part in activities such as building, drawing, threading beads, or filling and emptying containers in the water.










## CL – How you can help?

- Singing songs and nursery rhymes
- Taking time to listen to them talking about things they've done and answering their questions.

- Visit the library for story sessions.
- Asking for well-known stories to be retold in your child's own words.








## L - Literacy

Independent mark-making.






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## Literacy – How can you help?

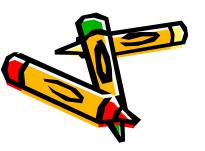
Encourage formation of lower case and capital letters to write name and all letters of the alphabet.


Reading a range of books (stories, information books, newspapers, magazines, comics etc), encouraging your child to join in and talk about books.

Read daily and write comments about your child's

reading in their school reading diary.

Teach the letter 'sounds' known as phonemes to blend words together.










## M - Mathematics

- 4 Measuring











## Mathematics– How can you help?

- Counting, adding and subtracting anything and everything - socks, cars, shopping, cutlery, fingers and toes!
- 4 Talk about the shapes you can see in the environment
- Comparing things which are heavy and light or long and short
- Pointing out numbers all around
- Singing counting songs and rhymes




# Expressive Arts and Design– How can you help?

- Encourage them to be flexible in their thinking and use of materials and praising them for their efforts or ideas as well as the end product
- Singing songs








### UW - Understanding the World

- Letting children join in with everyday activities washing up, cooking, shopping, helping in the garden...







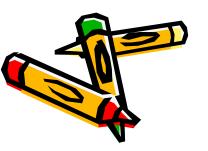


# P.E

   Please ensure trainers are velcro and not laces.




