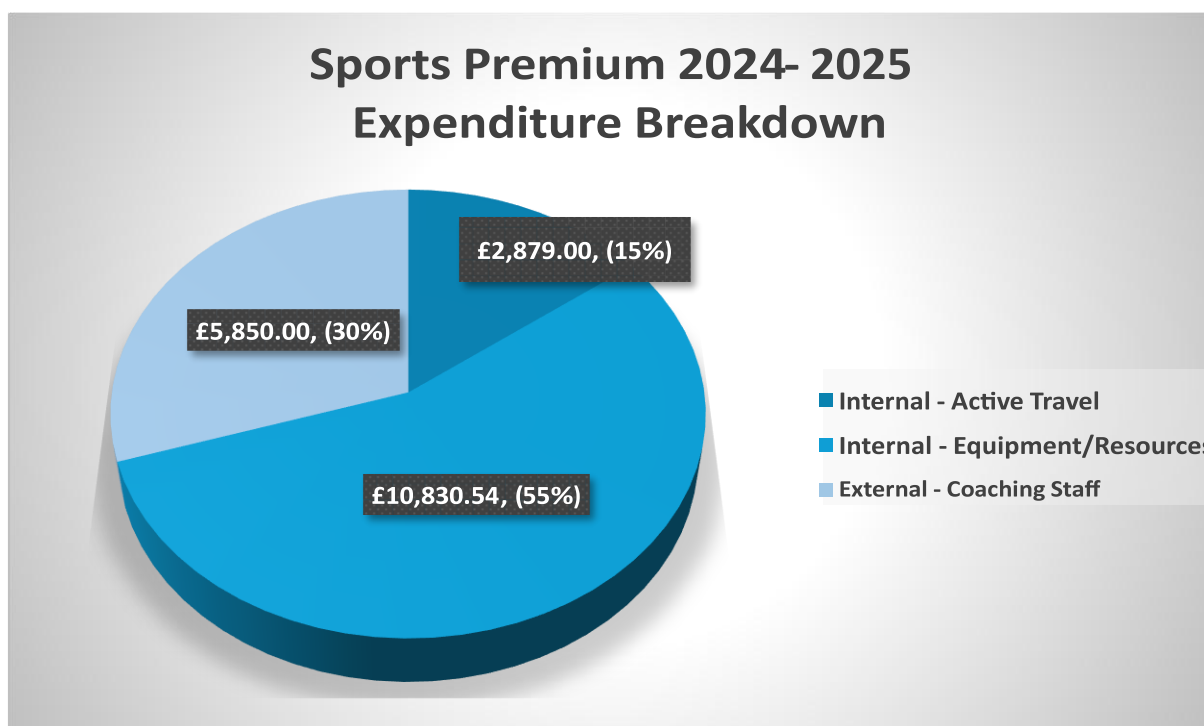


**Burleigh Primary School**

### **Opportunities in Sport**

**Has your school targeted any spending on providing or improving opportunities in PE, sport and physical activities for pupils with SEND or long-term medical conditions?**

Yes, by supporting participation in extra-curricular activities and purchasing specialist equipment and resources for children with long-term medical conditions.

**Has your school targeted any spending on providing or improving opportunities in sport and physical activities for disadvantaged pupils?**

Yes, by providing after school sport and physical activity clubs (eg karate) free of charge to all pupils and by safeguarding a given number of places in these clubs specifically for disadvantaged pupils.

**Perceived impacts and improvements**

**The sport premium funding has had a positive impact in the following areas:**

- increasing engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity and sport
  - raising the profile of PE and sport across the school to support whole school improvement
  - offering a broader and more equal experience of a range of sports and physical activities to all pupils
  - improving PE attainment
  - increasing teachers' confidence and competence in teaching PE and school sport
  - increasing pupil participation in extra-curricular activities.
