N.B No branded clothing, football kits or large logos should be worn please.

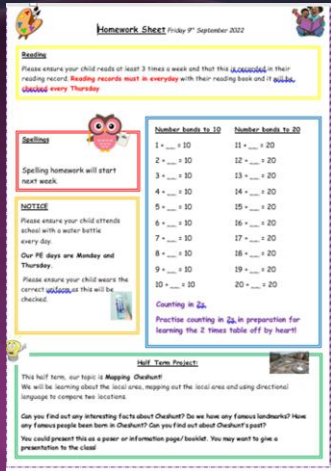
