## School Uniform

Thank you for the time and effort you put into ensuring your child has the correct uniform for school. Until the end of September, children have the option of wearing our summer uniform. If, however, your child is already wearing a shirt and is in Years 2-6, please make sure that they are also wearing a tie. Ties can either be purchased directly from the 'My Clothing' website, or from the school office (payment via the School Gateway). Thank you for also ensuring that your child wears black school shoes with their uniform. If you are unsure about our school uniform expectations, please go to the 'Parents' tab on our school website.



Children should come to school in their PE kits on the following days:

Reception – Monday (extended session)

Year 1 – Thursday (extended session)

Year 2 – Tuesday and Friday

Year 3 – Monday and Friday

Year 4 – Monday and Wednesday

Year 5 – Wednesday and Friday

Year 6 – Tuesday and Thursday

When the weather is warm, children should wear a Burleigh yellow PE T-shirt, blue shorts and **dark** trainers. When the days become cooler, children should wear a Burleigh hoodie / fleece over their yellow T-shirt, with plain **navy blue** jogging bottoms.

### School times

These are the same as they were last year. We open our doors from **8.40am** onwards and take the register at **8.50am**. Therefore, if your child could be sitting in their seat by **8.47am** it would be tremendously helpful. A calm start to the day benefits everyone, especially the children.
