This half term, we would like you to create a family portrait using just a pencil and paper. We will be learning how to show different relationships in Art and how to create different shades and tones using just a pencil.

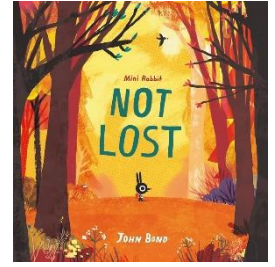
Take your time, think about the sizes and shapes of everyone in the picture in relation to each other and think about how someone looking at your picture will know it is a family. You can also include pets if you wish.
