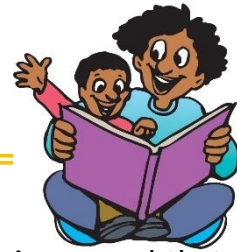


Homework Sheet

Be creative! Make a **home for a Prehistoric man or woman** using materials you have **at home** (like cardboard, sticks, or fabric).

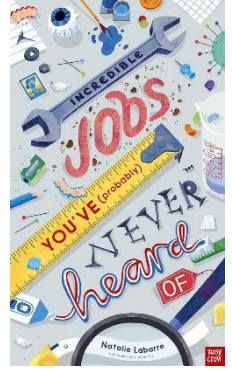
Choose one time period: **Stone Age, Bronze Age, Iron Age**
