Reading

Spellings



This week's spellings are based on the -able -ible suffixes.

The rule:

-able is more common than -ible

-able ending is usually used (but not always) if a complete root word can be heard before it e.g. changeable

The -ible is common if a complete root word cannot be heard before it e.g. flexible

Arithmetic practice

This week we would like you to practise questions using all four operations.
