Spellings



Thursday 4th December, we are going to do a spellings assessment made of 25 words chosen at random from all the spellings rules and patterns that we have covered across Year 4 so far. Here is a reminder:

- Week 1 - er sound words (ir/er/ur/ear/or)
- Week 2 - air sound words (are, air, ere, ear)
- Week 3 - words from the Year 2, 3 and 4 statutory word lists
- Week 4 - ed and ing suffixes
- Week 5 - er and est suffixes
- Week 6 - consonant suffixes (ful, ment, less, ness)
- Week 7 - ly suffix
- Week 8 - tion and ation suffixes
- Week 9 - sion and ssion suffixes
- Week 10 - cian suffixes

Tip - when adding suffixes, we may need to apply the following rules: drop the e, change the y to i, double the consonant.

You can look back at the previous homework sheets on the website, for example spelling words.
