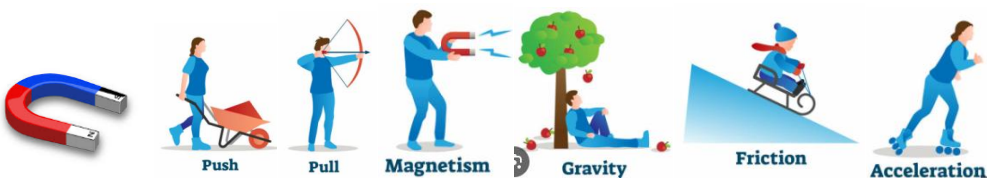

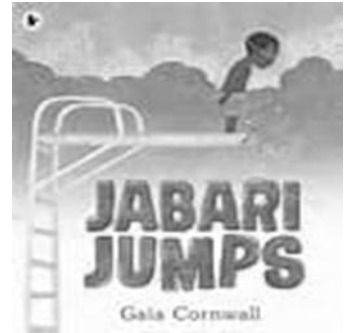
This Week's Learning
