We have noticed that some children have been bringing in small toys, lip palms and other items from home into school. Please can you keep such items at home. Thank you.

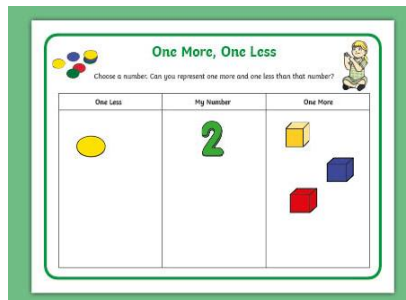
Half Term
