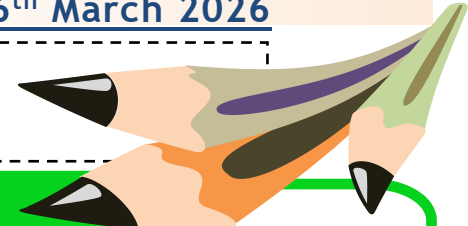

Cheshunt Library

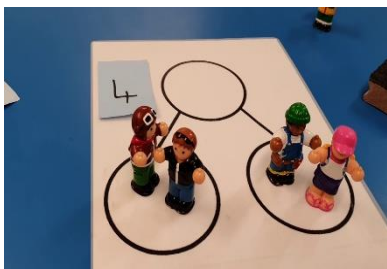
The children had a lovely time at the library on Tuesday. They explored the books in the children's section and listened to a story too. Thank you to all our parent volunteers!!
