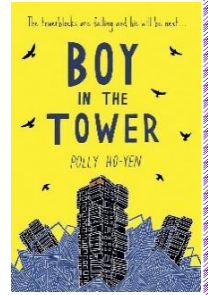

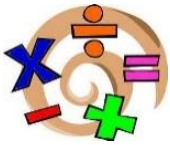
Spelling practice space if needed









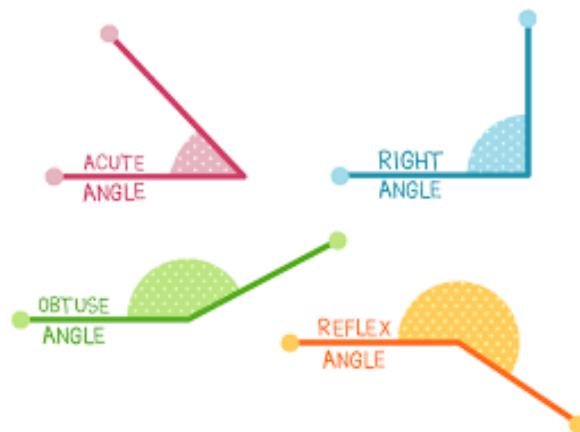
Challenge: Write a short description of what you think the Bluchers look like.
