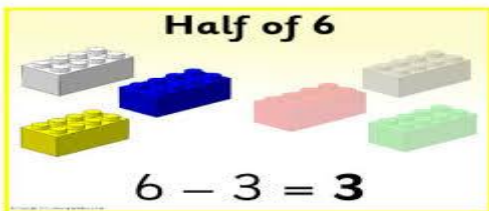


Foundation Stage Newsletter
