Theme: Trees

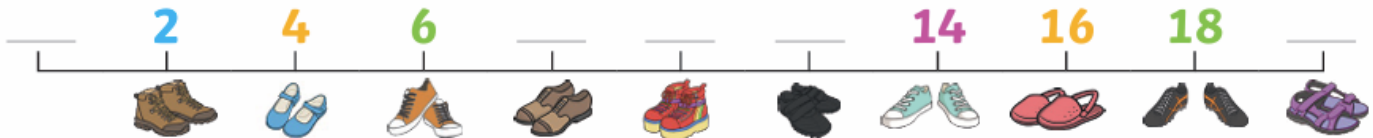
Keywords: deciduous and evergreen
