Theme: Transport

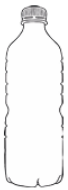
Keywords: transport, journey

nearly full

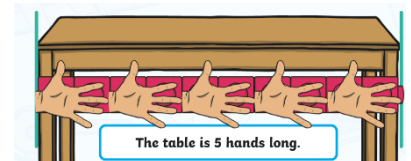


nearly empty
