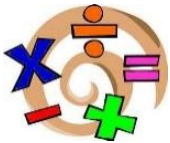

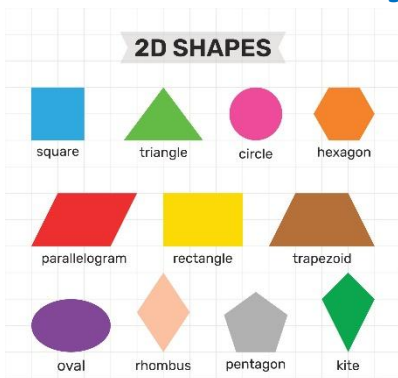


Challenge: Write a short script to advertise one of these products: a pair of shoes that can make you fly, a watch that makes you travel through time, or a ring that gives you energy.

Foundation Subject

Science: Next week, we will complete our work in the topic of 'Animals including Humans' by further considering the different stages of development and looking at 'old age' in more detail.

Challenge: Draw a poster showing the different stages of human development and the milestones included in each stage.
