Write the time shown on each clock.



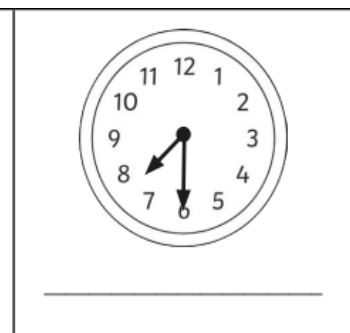
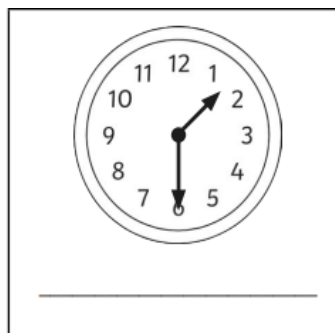
