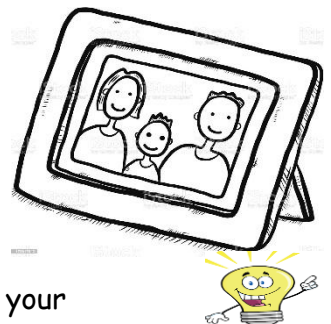

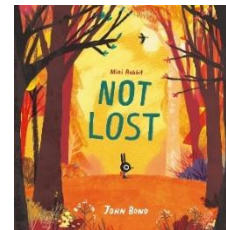
Half-Term Project

We have been practising joining two independent clauses together using a co-ordinating conjunction.

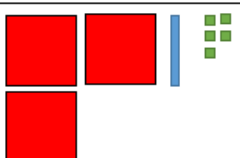
