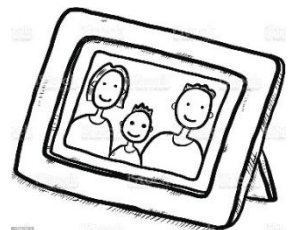
Times Tables - Use your 3 times table to work out the missing numbers
